



Vehicle Maintenance

The most important cost saving measure that you can take besides a safe food delivery program is an aggressive maintenance program for your vehicle. Like any piece of equipment for your business or organization will enhance the performance and aesthetics and will greatly lengthen the life of your vehicle.

It is important to remember one thing about maintenance – once you let it get ahead of you, it becomes increasingly difficult and more costly to maintain.

Use the following suggested maintenance checklist to keep your vehicle in shape. Besides organizing and regimenting the maintenance. These forms also let you know who is responsible for the vehicle during their shift.

- Follow the Thermo-king manufacturers suggested maintenance schedule, and we suggest that the refrigeration unit be taken in for preventative maintenance once a year to an authorized dealer (list provided).
- Check all engine belts once every 30 days
- Check all radiator hoses every 30 days.
- Check the hoses under the vehicle every 30 days.
- Check the grills inside the hot & cold boxes for blockage every day
- Follow the vehicle manufacturers suggested maintenance schedule under the ""Heavy Duty ""applications i.e.: Tune-ups, Oil Changes, etc...
